



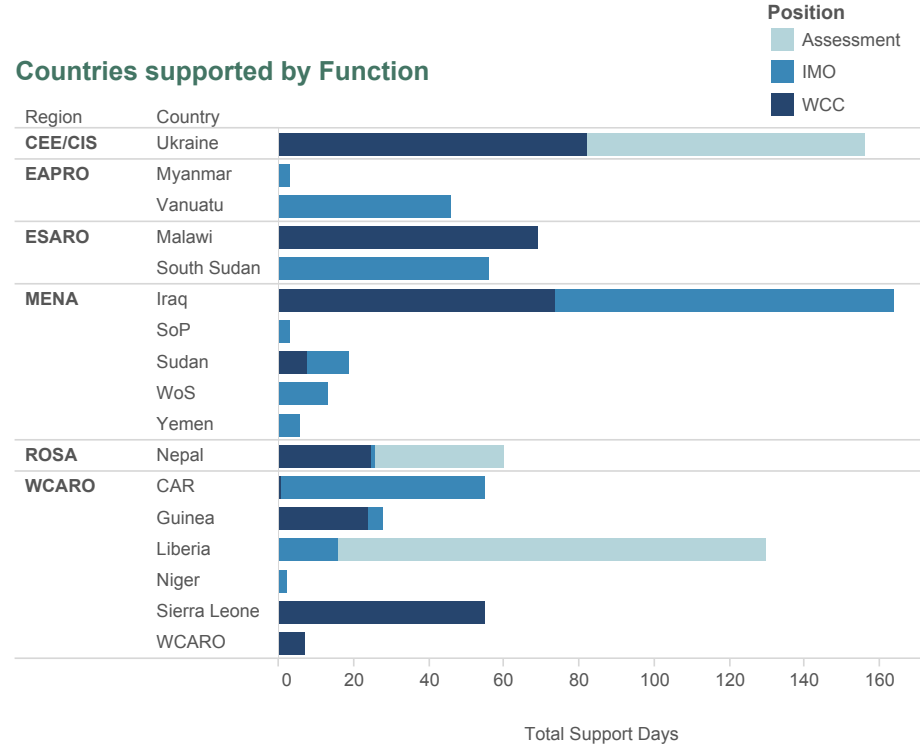
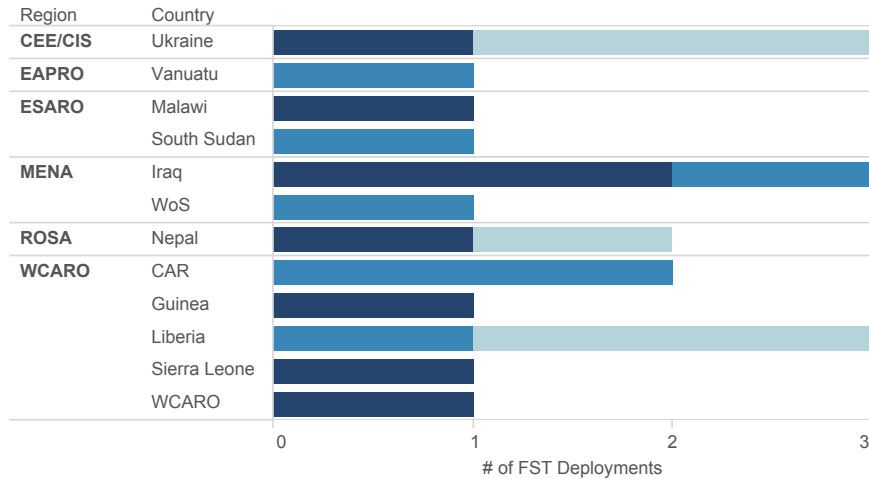
Field Support Team Statistics 2015

2015 saw the establishment of the Field support Team (FST), which is operationalized through a consortium of NGOs led by IFRC, supported by ECHO, MoFA (Norway) and OFDA.

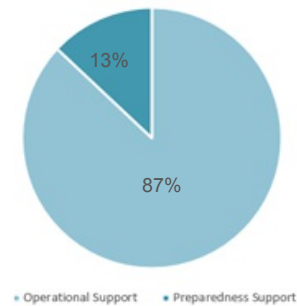
The FST provides timely, relevant support to humanitarian WASH coordination platforms as surge during emergency operations, remote technical support and capacity building pre, during and post crisis.

In 2015, 17 countries requested support in existing and / or worsening complex emergencies, (Syria, S.Sudan, Yemen, CAR and Iraq), onset disasters (Nepal, Vanuatu) and newly activated coordination mechanisms (Ukraine). There were also continued efforts to support coordination and recovery planning to the Ebola outbreak in West Africa.

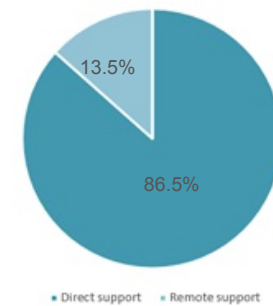

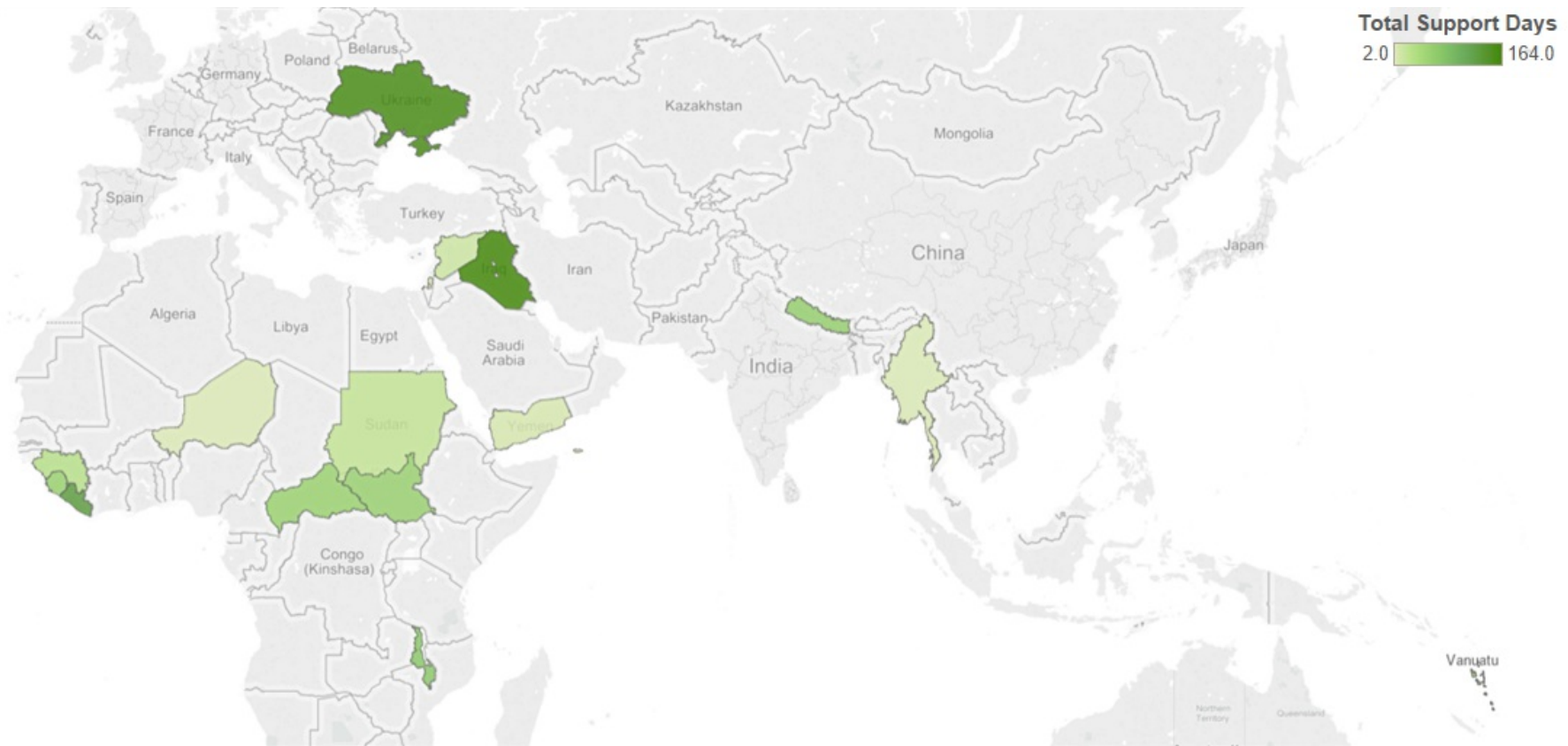
Operational vs. Preparedness Support
